Why the Turkish energy market?



Turkey is an 80 million population market with a great need of know-how in the energy sector and the will to invest in green energy research & technology. It is Turkey's ambition to fund all qualified R&D projects with Turkish partners within the programmes Eurostars/EUREKA.

- Electricity consumption will on the avg. increase by <u>5-6 %</u> per year
- 40 GW/130 billion \$ investment need in the electricity sector till 2020.
- 2023 Targets for Turkey supported by new incentives:
 - ✓ 30 % RE in the overall electricity production
 - ✓ 20.000 MW wind/3.000 MW solar /600 MW biomass energy.

Cost of being a delegate

- <u>6,000 DKK per company</u> to be paid to the Trade Council Turkey for the services mentioned above.
- Airfare, hotel and other costs will be covered by the participant.
- Each company can have 1 participant as a delegate and there will be an additional fee of 3,000 DKK for another delegate
